## Elaboration of environment economic accounts (synergy with other activities)

- In synergy with the cooperation project with Sweden Statistics Office,
   NBS began elaboration of the environmental account of emissions in
   atmospheric air in accordance with Methodological guide for
   calculations "System of Environmental-Economic Accounting" Central
   Framework. In 2018 performing experimental calculations of emissions
   for 2014 2016.
- After approval of methodology of calculations this subject will be included in the annual Program of statistical works for their further permanent implementation.







#### **Sustainability and connectivity**
