Costs of local transports are covered by the per-diem.


By Metro:

The Metro station in the airport is located at the very end of Terminal 3. Once exiting baggage reclaim just walk straight ahead, up the escalators, or take the elevator up to level 1 by following the Metro signs. Take the train direction Vanløse (M2, yellow line) and get out at the stop Kongens Nytorv.





Tickets for the Metro are available at the Metro station and at the ticket sales counter in Terminal 3. You need a **3-zone ticket to Kongens Nytorv** (ticket price is 36 DKK ~ 4.83 EUR).
