

- > 350 national bodies dealing with environmental information




Eionet structure (European vs. national)




 A regional project - support to EU policies and external policy framework (Eastern Partnership)

Continue to build on EEA long-term engagement and strengthen the SEIS pillars through partnerships via knowledge sharing



















