- Coordinate the **European environment information and observation network (Eionet)**



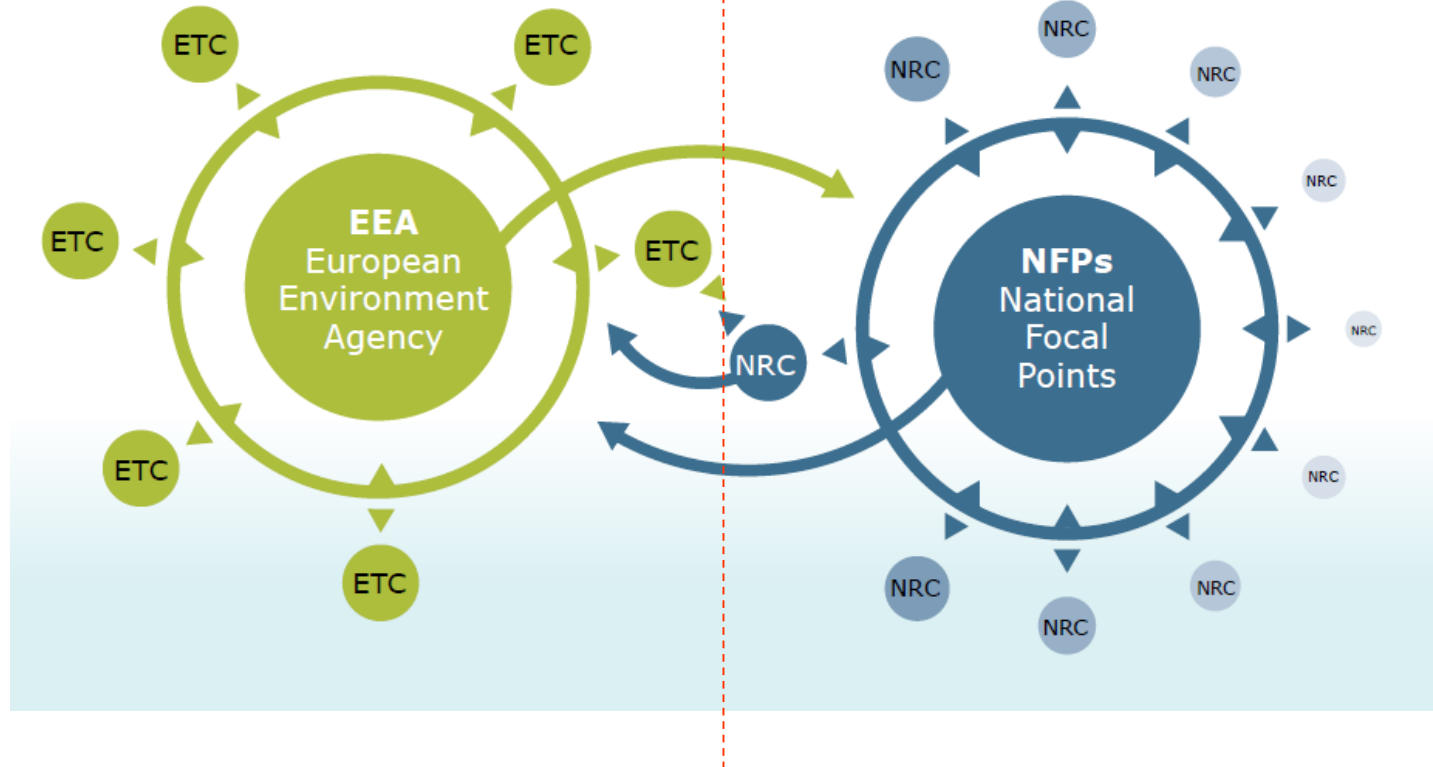
Eionet is a network of around:

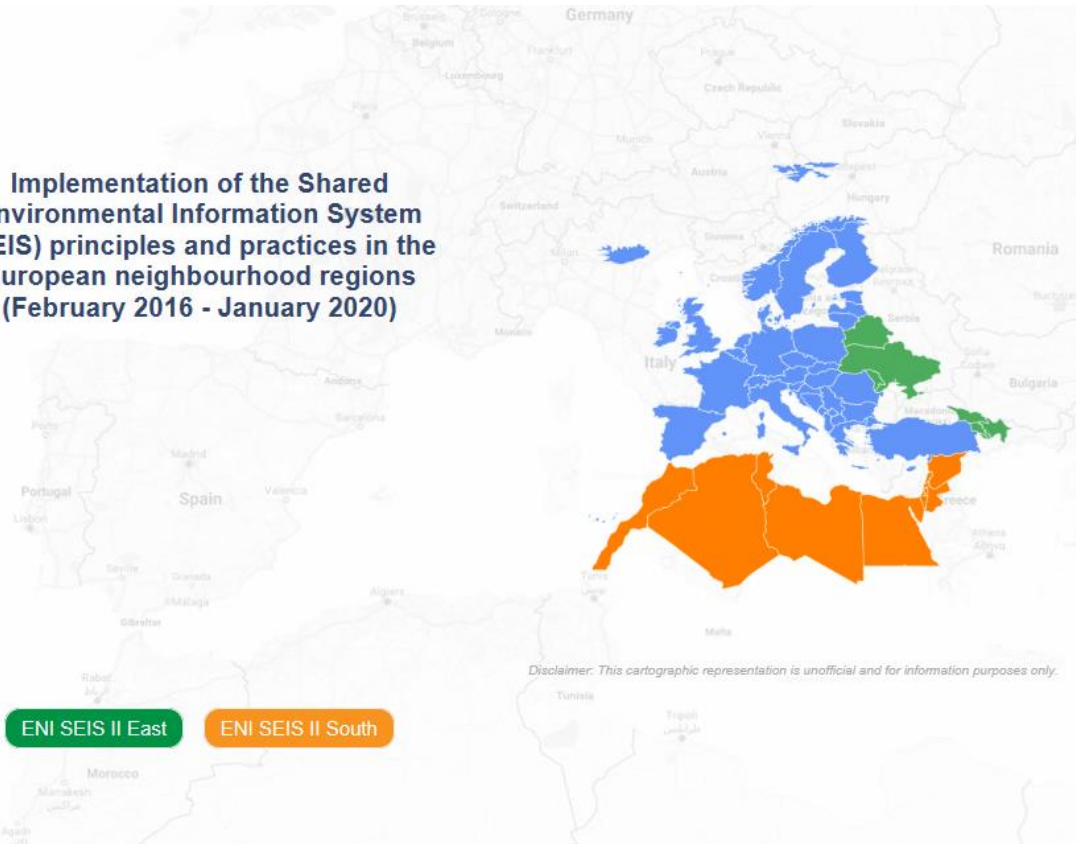

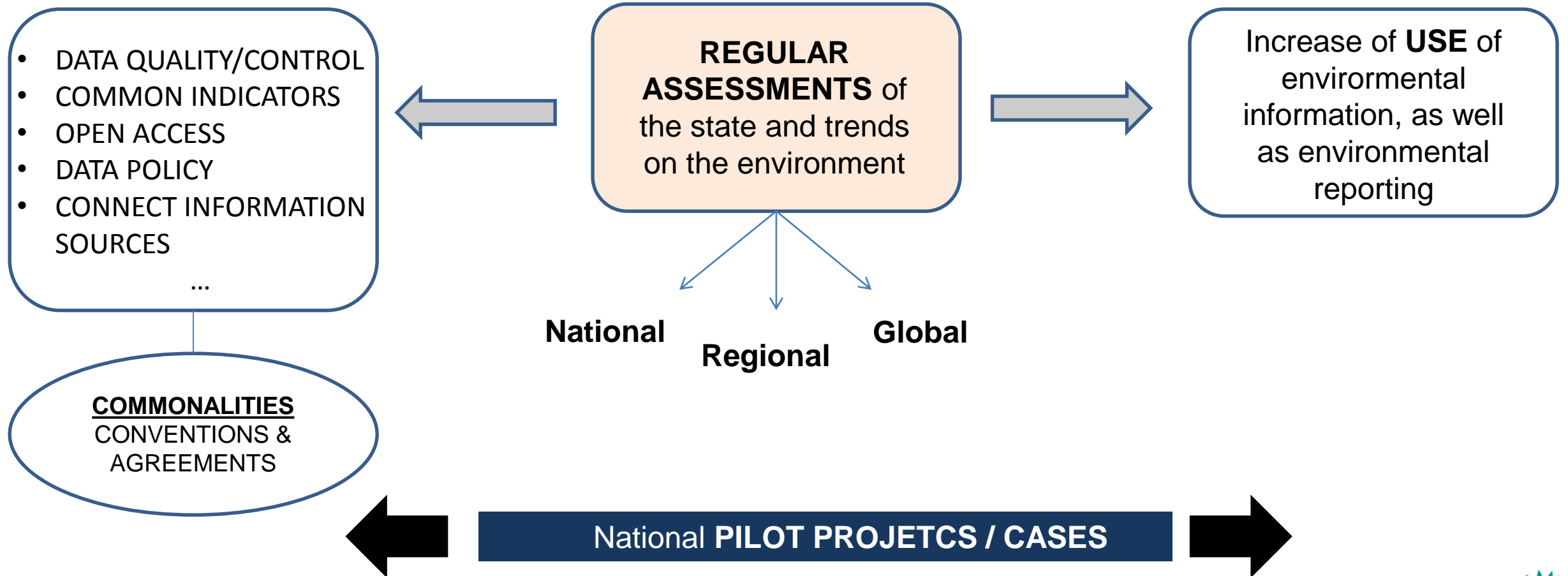

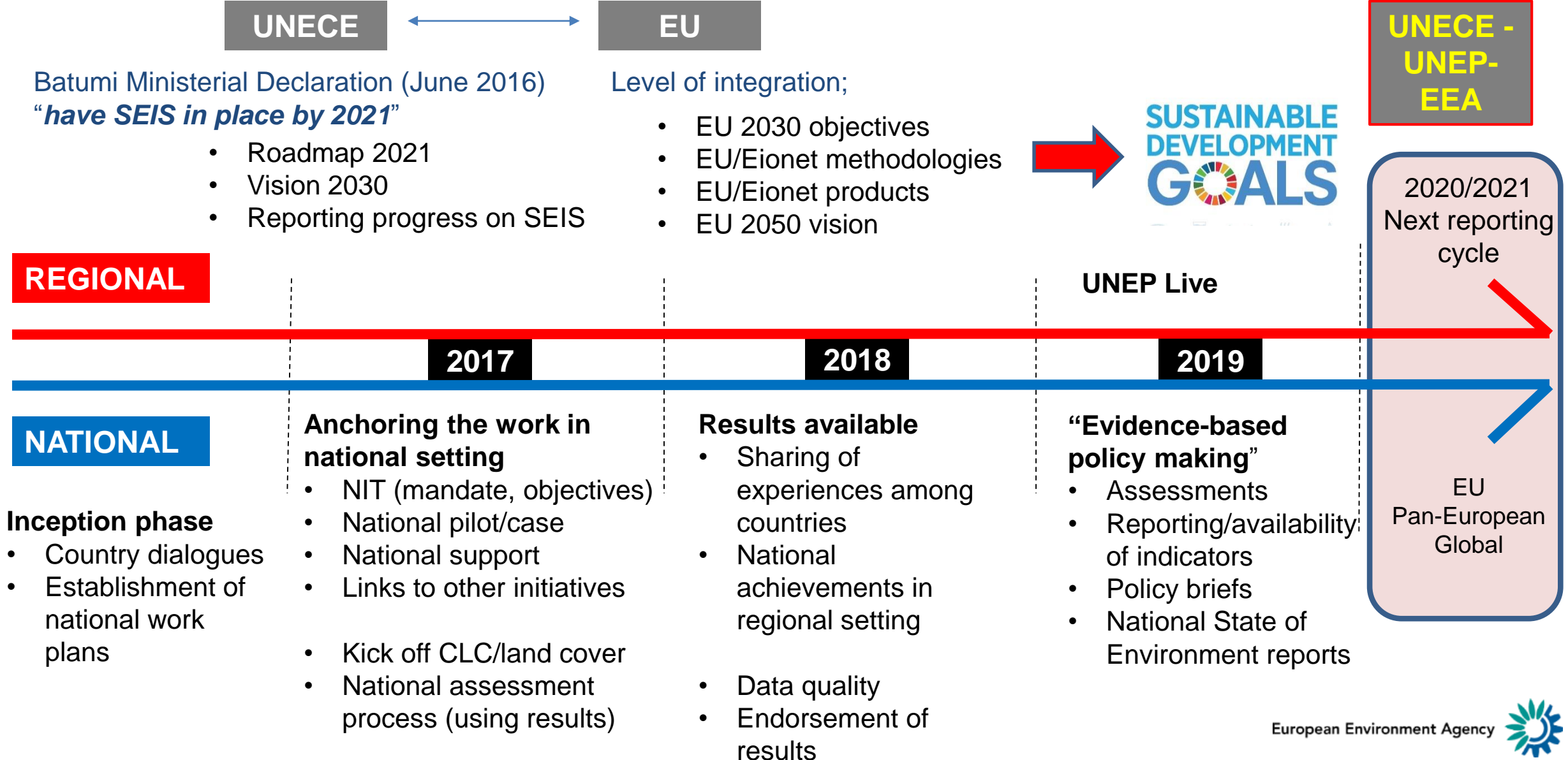
Continue to build on EEA long-term engagement and strengthen the SEIS pillars through partnerships via knowledge sharing

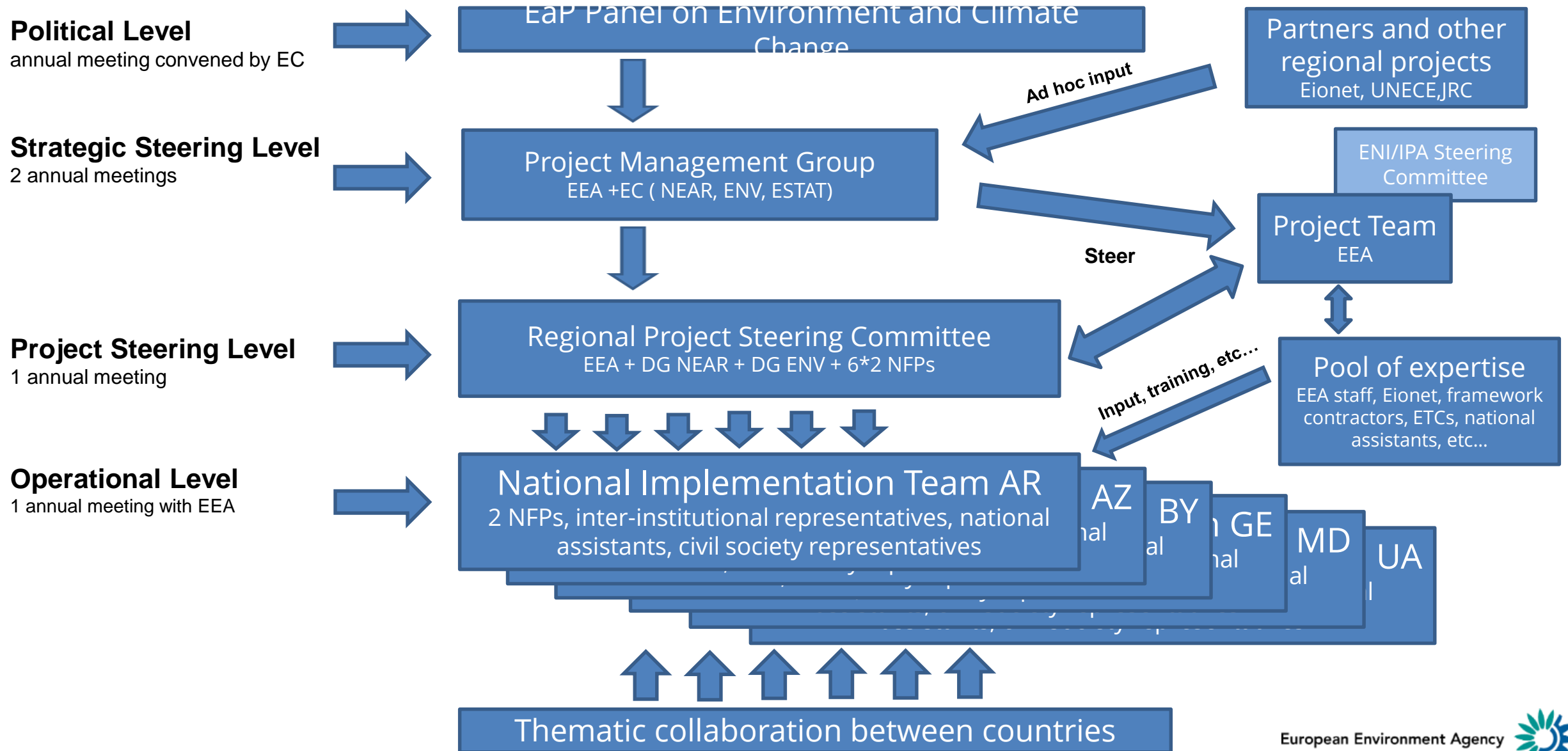

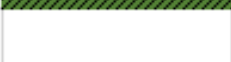
