About this document

The document provides the structure of the Assessment Fact Sheets for H2020/NAP.

It is composed of two parts:

- i. **Template for Indicators Assessment**, repeated for each H2020/NAP indicator
- ii. **Template for Thematic Assessment**, providing an integrated assessment for a particular thematic based on the corresponding indicator assessments

The indicator assessment should build on the Indicator Specification Fact Sheets¹, previously developed for each H2020/NAP indicator, which provide guidance and information on methodological aspects for populating the indicator.

The templates for Indicator/Thematic Assessments follow closely the structure of the Indicator Guidance document (also referred to as the Country Level Assessment Approach)², which provides guidance on how the templates should be filled in.

Countries are encouraged to follow these assessment templates to display the national assessment of each H2020/NAP indicators as well as to provide an integrated assessment of each of the three H2020 priority themes.

As the assessments are meant to be updated on regular basis – to capture any changes within the policy framework/policy questions, and/or to reflect update in the underpinning data sets, it's important to record carefully the version, date and authors/contributors of the assessment to ensure traceability of the work.

NOTE that the indicator factsheet is fully completed when the assessment is carried out and the methodological specification updated to reflect any national methodological adjustment made to produce the indicator (adjustment to the definition, calculation, methodology for data gap filling, policy context, uncertainties, etc).

Once completed, those indicator factsheets (assessment + methodology) are meant to be published, either on national website, and/or on project website, EEA website, UNEP/MAAP website.
