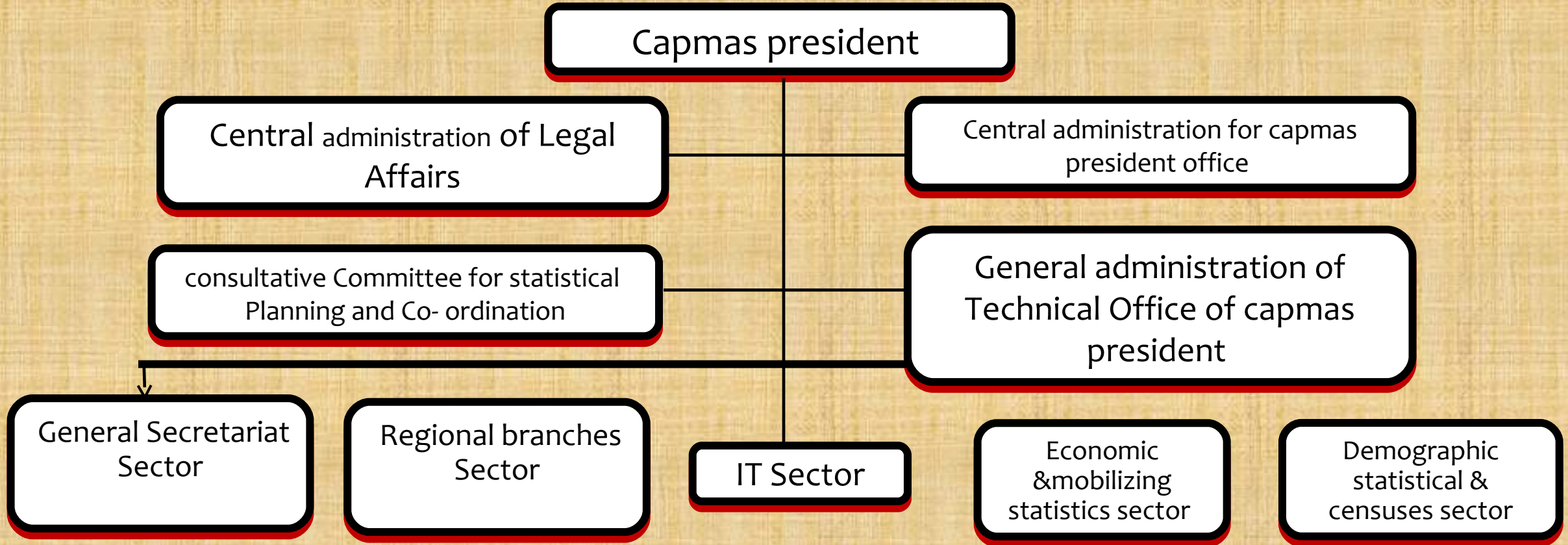

# ***INTRODUCTION***

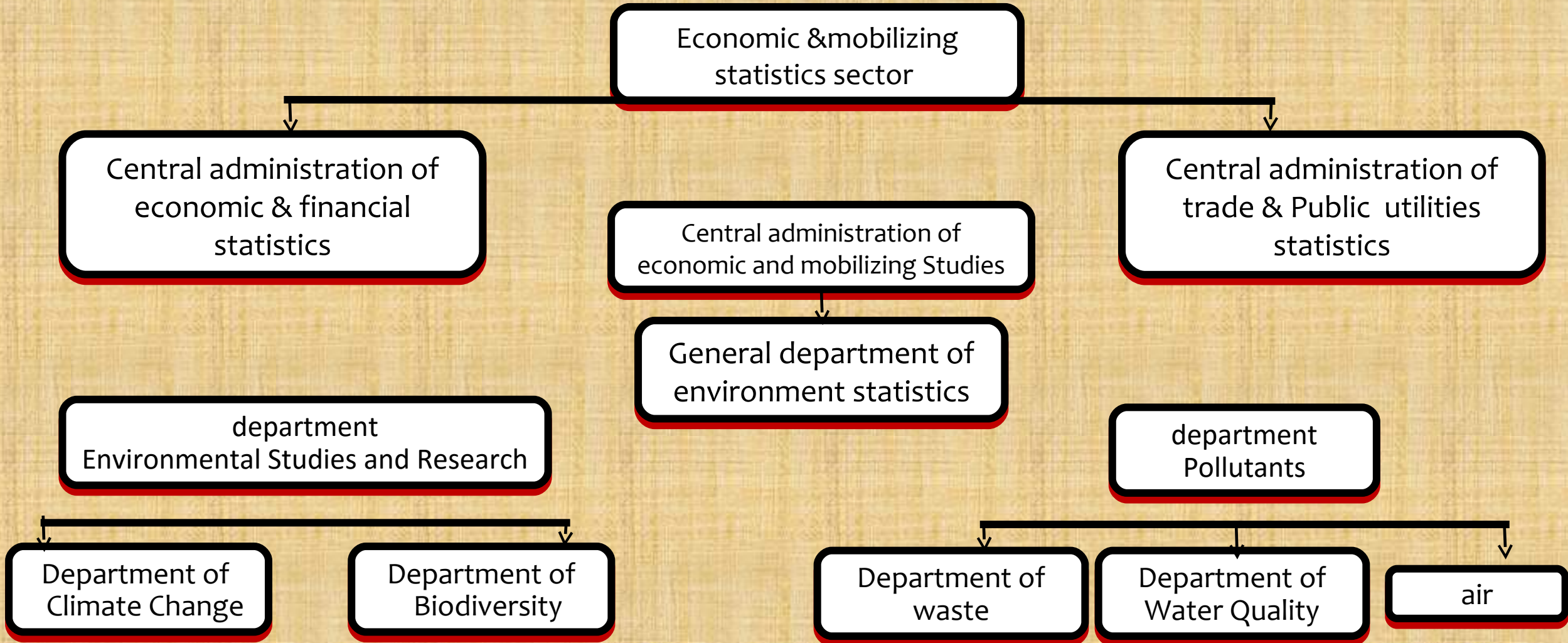

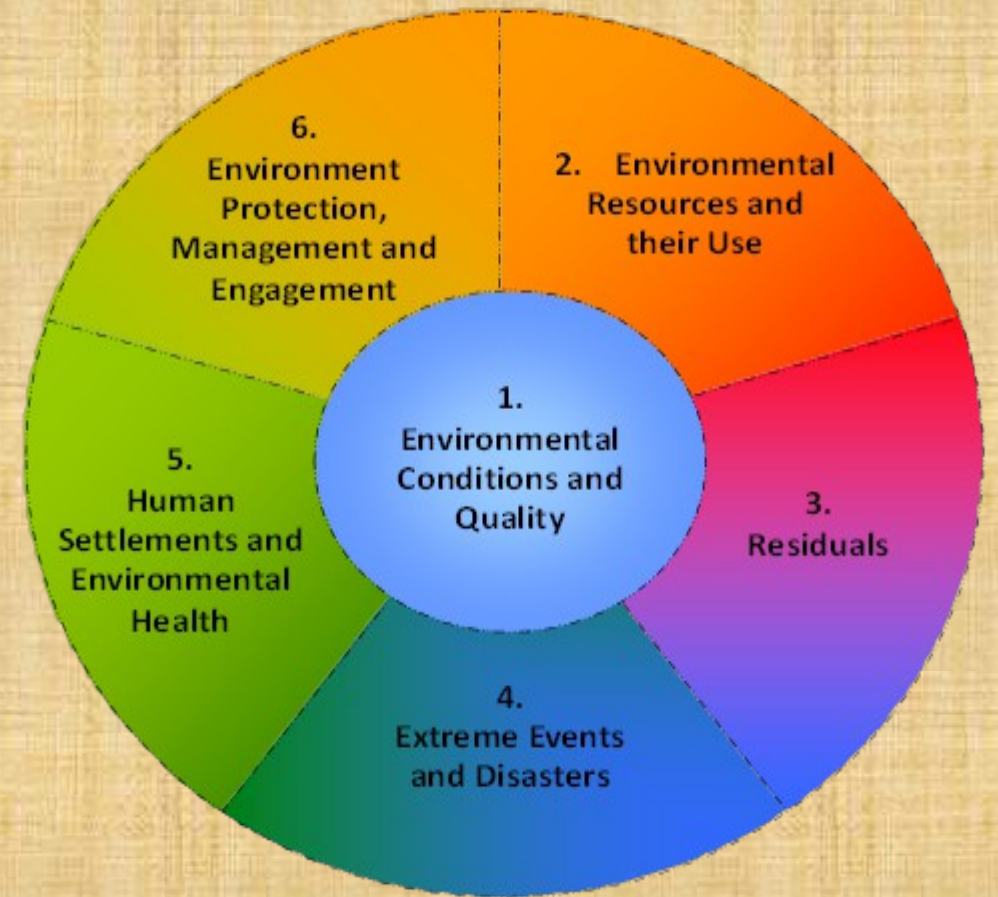

## **National Needs:**

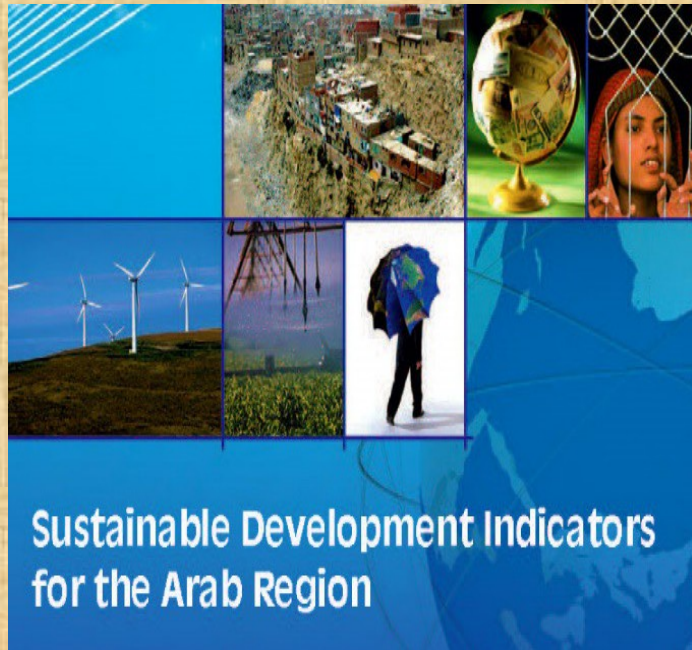

- National Strategy for the development of statistics (NSDS).

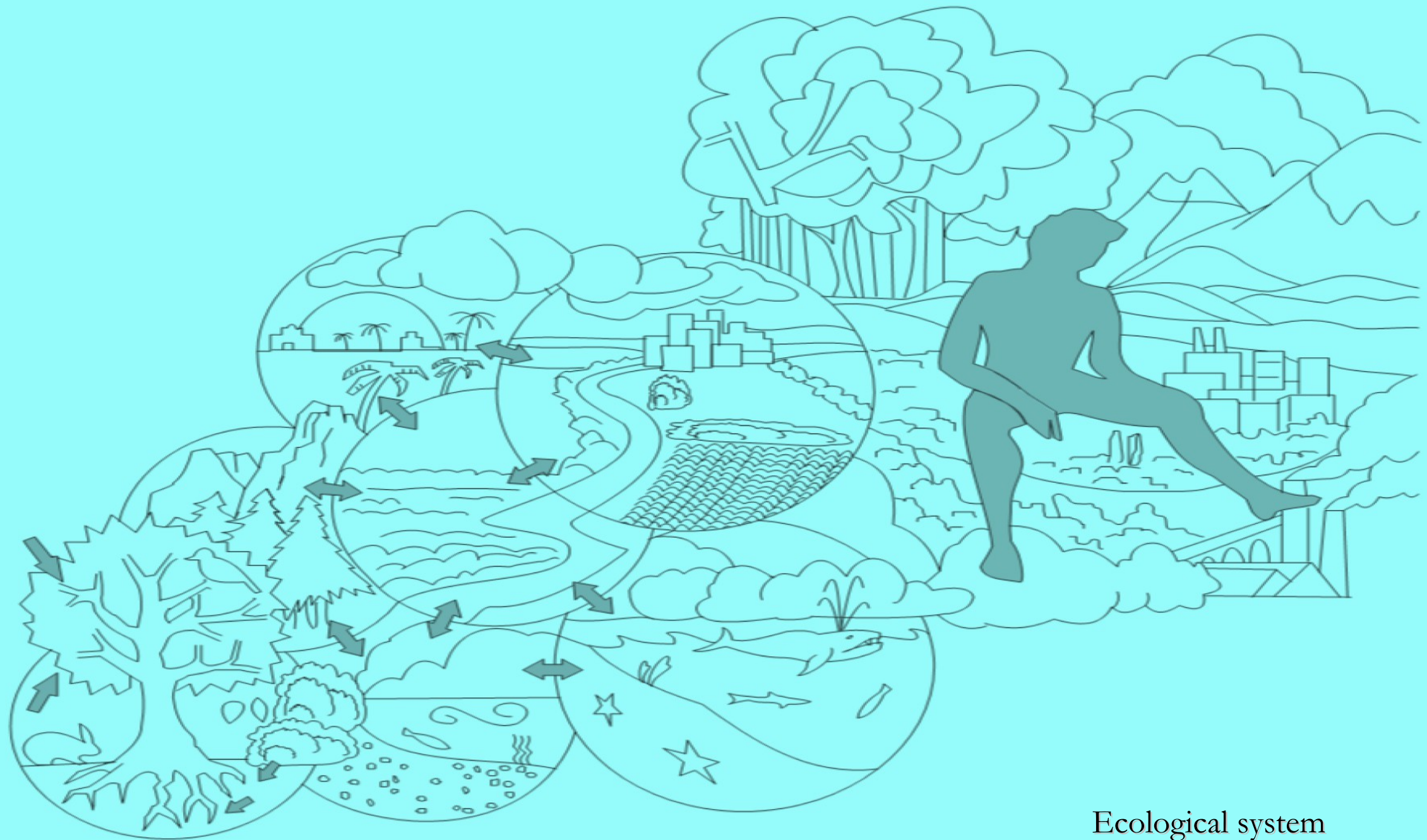


# ***THE NEEDS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL STATISTICS. (CONT'D)***
