The Draft Libya national work Plan for the Implementation of the Shared Environmental Information System (SEIS)



National Team

The National team have just recently been established. The National Team Consist of the following stakeholders there are from the :- Ministries of: planning; (Bureau of Statistics & Census), Local Gov., Energy, Environmental General Authority, Water General Authority and Industrial General Authority, All these institutions have appointed a representative except the Industrial General Authority have not yet replied, but we expected them do so soon. In the past as well as currently we have the problem of lack coordination between the different sectors. Therefore we hope that the effectiveness of the relationship between all various stakeholders, on information exchange should be improved, and became more effective. (The establishment of Environmental Indicators Unit at Bureau of Statistics & Census which to be run jointly with EGA would be the Milestone to this)

- -The team in its first introductory meeting have listed several questions and considerations that should be addressed Such as:
- -There are a general agreement among all the stakeholders that this project is vital for Libya, as it has no Sustainable System for reporting on Environmental Indicators or even state of the environment report yet .
- -This project comes at the right time as the country trying also to work on the SDGs report.
- What are the Indicators that should be selected and How be applied in a reporting system that is effective and sustainable.
 We agreed that the Indicators must be understood and of interest to lots of people.
- -The country needs assistance in improving our statistical systems so as to measure our development progress, help guide policy and participate effectively at national, regional and international monitoring programmes

Expected Outcomes from the National Team

-The Main task of the team is to produce work plan and Enhanced capacities of to develop and implement it, through a most effective reporting system for Environmental Indicators.
-The reporting systems if established will strengthened EGA and the Bureau of Statistics & Census capacity at the regional and international Network Facility that facilitates effective knowledge

sharing and exchange of environmental information.

- It is anticipated that various aspects of the work plan will be implemented by different actors, and therefore synergies with SDGs can be derived
- The National Team through the newly established Environmental Indicators Unit (EIU) to be located at the Bureau of Statistic and to be run jointly by the Environment General Authority and the Bureau of Statistic will guide and oversee the implementation of the work plan. As stated above, the overall objective of the work plan is to complement the relevant SEIS with a view to improving environmental policies in Libya and to contribute to the Regional activity of H2020. It will also build Libya capacity to implement, comply with and enforce regional and international environmental agreements and address Libya environmental challenges effectively within the overall context of the implementation of SEIS
