# Key recommendations – Actions list

---

Inter institutional cooperation / national governance

Make more visible the work of national committee/team and it's mandate, member composition, activities

Ensure coordination of national activities and establishment of platform for sharing data and information

Formalise the working model for the joint cooperation with all partners concerned

Develop a common vision for a shared environmental information system

State of the Environment – identification of key priorities/issues to be tackled by next report and identify relevant corresponding indicators, organise the working mechanisms (national committee/team) to allow effective data and information exchanges

Introduce outlook perspectives

Support better integration of data sources and inputs from thematic networks, including private sectors, NGOs, University

Implementation of ENI SEIS II SSFA – ensure involvement of all members of the national team to ensure proper synergies, convergence with other relevant national activities



# Actions list

---

Ensure complementarity of NMISW and waste to energy projects

Important that all stakeholders have access to the information system/baseline data (current and future) to support current development on waste management (e.g. incineration)

Ensure a regular monitoring of industrial emissions

Establish an information system for industrial emissions to connect industries to MoE – similar to waste IS and water IS

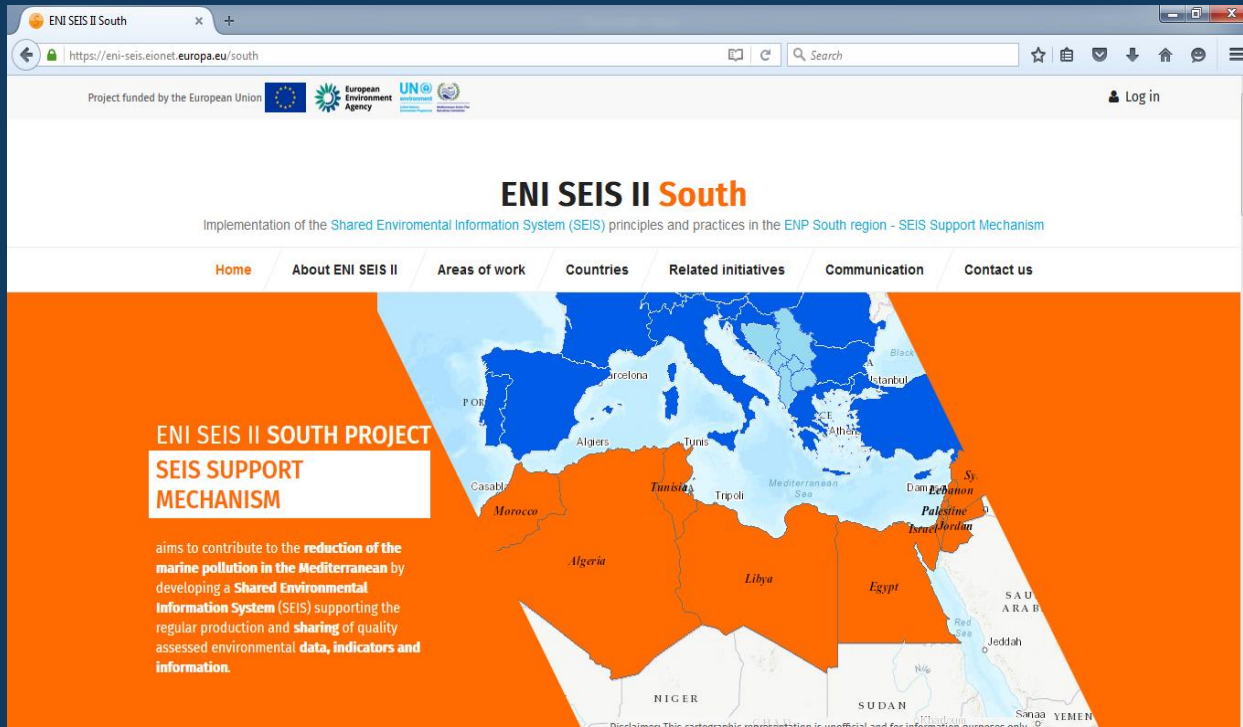
Ensure comprehensive awareness (training) as regard national environmental targets and thresholds

Involve national standards organisation (JSMO) to adopt international standards in data management and infrastructure development

Ensure dissemination to national committee/network (university) of useful resources linked to the project development
