- How successful are these measures and how do they compare across the region?

- What is the comparative performance tackling these sources of pollution across the region?
- What is the 2020 outlook for each priority area in question?
- What are the foreseen main development in coming decade (2020-2050), that could be expected to contribute most to future environmental pressures?
