# **Objectif of group work**

On the basis of the revised H2020 scope and taken into account existing indicator processes and other indicator-based assessments

- to review each existing H2020 indicators rational, scope, data constraints, reporting, initial assessment
- to propose potential update, revision
- to identify additional indicators
- => Propose a revised set (max 20/25 indicators)
  - ad-hoc working group to further work on this proposal (feasibility) and refined the set
  - September workshop to work on indicators specification and agree on final set

- Be simple, straight-forward, concise, easy to interpret,
- Be issue specific yet relevant to all countries,
- Build on existing indicators process in the region to ensure full use of existing information and data,
- Provide realistic and representative baseline of the current situation,
- Contribute to a balanced DPSIR distribution,
- Provide a comprehensive, yet non-exhaustive coverage of the priority areas,
- Allow for periodic review and update in line with future developments.
