Objectif of group work

on the basis of the revised H2020 scope and taken into account existing indicator processes and other indicator-based assessments

- **to review each existing H2020 indicators – rational, scope, data constraints, reporting, initial assessment**
 - **to propose potential update, revision**
 - **to identify additional indicators**
-
- **=> Propose a revised set (max 20/25 indicators)**
 - **ad-hoc working group to further work on this proposal (feasibility) and refined the set**
 - **September workshop to work on indicators specification and agree on final set**

Indicator selection criteria

- **Be simple, straight-forward, concise, easy to interpret,**
- **Be issue specific yet relevant to all countries,**
- **Build on existing indicators process in the region to ensure full use of existing information and data,**
- **Provide realistic and representative baseline of the current situation,**
- **Contribute to a balanced DPSIR distribution,**
- **Provide a comprehensive, yet non-exhaustive coverage of the priority areas,**
- **Allow for periodic review and update in line with future developments.**
