

## Selection of a first set of indicators in 2016

- 1<sup>st</sup> Workshop on MSSD 2016-2015 Monitoring March 30-31 2016 Saint-Laurent du Var France.
- Selection of a first set of 34 priority indicators from different Indicators sets including SDG indicators
- Completed with 15 Easy-to-update indicators already selected for the MSSD 2005
- Assessment of the first set of indicators (Mid-July October)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Workshop on MSSD 2016-2025 Monitoring, Barcelona October 17, jointly with SCP Indicators and Blue Economy Indicators



#### Assessment of the first set of indicators

The indicators have been classified in 3 major categories:

Status of the Indicators	Nb of Indicators
Factsheets available	24
Factsheet in progress	15
Indicators with some issues	9

- The indicators of the 3<sup>rd</sup> category need to be
- **1. Better defined**
- 2. Replaced
- 3. Cancelled
- 4. Populated with the cooperation of the national institutions/experts



# Ongoing and planned activities in 2017

- Finalise the ongoing factsheets
- Assess some new indicators and elaborate the related factsheets
- Online consultation of the core set of indicators and factsheets (Focal Points) then presentation/discussions at the MCSD meeting (July 2017)
- Update the assessment of the core set according the comments from MSCD SC, MCSD members and Focal Points (reduce the number of indicators)
- Revise the core set of indicators and factsheets
- Include all the factsheets in the Sustainability dashboard to be adopted by the COP 20 by the end of 2017
