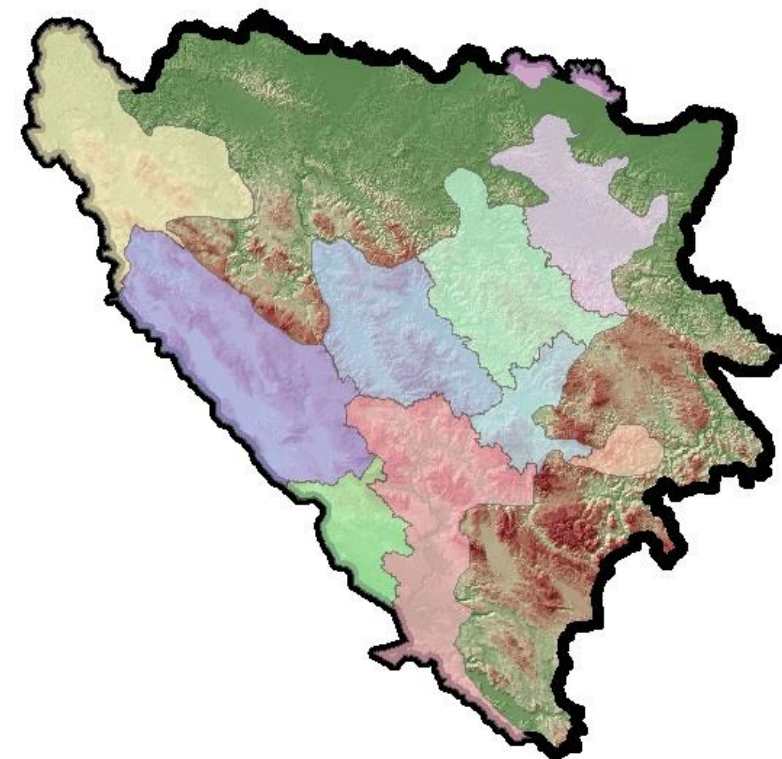

Improvements

Significant progress has been made in terms of monitoring and pollution control, including:

- improvement in water monitoring;
- strengthening activities to reduce emissions and monitor emissions of large polluters;
- and the development of a pollution and release register.

However, there is little progress in the development of a comprehensive monitoring system, an integral spatial information system or a national environmental information system, including a central database.

NAP

- Developing a monitoring program for the Mediterranean area of BiH with an emphasis on the marine environment and protection until 2019.
- Expand the existing sewerage to achieve 90% coverage for the city of Mostar
- Expand the existing sewage system to achieve the average connection rate of 50% by 2019. and 70% by 2023
- Complete the construction, test work and commissioning of WWTP in Mostar until 2019; Ensure Complete the construction, testing and commissioning of WWTP in Capljina until 2023
- Construction of operational units of biological treatment for secondary treatment of wastewater to UPOV in Neum until 2022;
- Increase in the operational capacity of WWTP in Trebinje

NAP

- Construction of sanitary landfill adequate for EU standards for Mostar until 2020
- Urgent closure of illegal landfills in the border area until 2019
- Construction of sanitary landfill adequate for EU standards for the Trebisnjica River Basin
- Establish a system (competent waste management company, municipal waste collection infrastructure, collection / separation / reuse / safe disposal of separate waste components) for municipalities with more than 10,000 inhabitants (50% of municipalities by 2019, 95% of municipalities until 2025)
